MENTAL PATIENTS GET MANY GIFTS

NEWTOWN, Dec. 28.—With a record number of gifts donated, patients at the Fairfield State hospital here had a joyous Christmas. Three hundred patients were able to be at home with families and friends. For the 2,570 remaining in the hospital, the day began with special church services. At noon a complete turkey dinner was served and each patient was the recipient of several gifts besides candy and tobacco. According to Dr. William F. Green, Superintendent, a large part of the credit for this must go to the people in surrounding towns and cities who responded most generously to the annual gift appeal which was conducted in the weeks before Christmas. Most of the thousands of gifts received were distributed on Christmas Day and at parties held during the preceding days. Duplicate gifts and those arriving late are kept on hand and are given to patients on their birthdays and on other holidays throughout the year. They will also be used as prizes for games and parties. Checks and cash received are deposited in the Patients' Activity Fund which is used for recreation, outings, the purchase of athletic equipment and record players. Dr. Green and all the members of the hospital staff wish to extend their sincere thanks to everyone who made a donation, to those who encouraged others to give and who helped by accepting and transporting the gifts to the hospital, and to the many volunteers who assisted with the tremendous task of wrapping, sorting, and distributing the gifts to the patients. Their thanks are also extended to all the churches, organizations and individuals who assisted with parties and entertainments during the holiday season. All of these kind remembrances have helped to give the patients their happiest Christmas.
