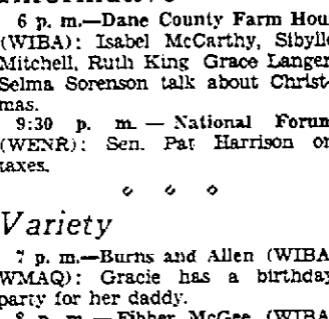

## SHORT WAVE NEWS

Short wave listeners when have been enjoying the excellent programs from "Radio National", Switzerland, will be glad to know that the league has voted to increase its broadcasting schedule for 1938. Only 70 hours of broadcasting were radiated during 1937 but present plans call for 140 hours next year, beginning in January.

Java is always an intriguing "catch" for the distance-loving short wave fan. Fortunately, YDB at Soerabaja can almost always be depended upon at 4:45 a. m. Located on a frequency of 9.55 megacycles, this station is by far one of the most dependable of all the Javanese stations at the present time. From this station you will hear varied musical entertainment, sometimes including native Javanese music.

At 3:30 a. m. Manila is being heard regularly with a signal that dominates the 31-meter band. Tune to 9:57 megacycles.

Reception from Europe during the past week or so has been of varied quality. While signals have for the most part been strong, fading has prevented full enjoyment of programs. Most affected of all the European programs have been those from Holland. This station, usually one of the strongest of all the evening broadcasters, almost completely faded out on its most recent transmission.
