Born in Madison-co, Kentucky, on Christmas Eve 1809,Carson started traveling carly in life and never wholly settled down. While still a baby his parents loaded Kit and their household goods into 21 covered wagon and moved west to Howard-co, Missouri, then on the edge of the Indian country. He learned to ride and shoot as soon as he could wellas he could walk.

At the age of 15 he became a saddler's apprentice, but his restless spirit demanded action and at the age of 17 he joined a wag-on train headed for Santa Fe, New Mexico. From then on he New Mexico. was involved in one adventure after another. While still a young man Carson served as guide to remote John Charles Freemont,
