The 150th anniversary of the first congress ever held in the United States will be hailed over the combined networks of the major broadcasting companies Saturday when President Roosevelt, Chief Justice Charles Evans Hughes, Sen. Key Pittman (D., Nev.), and Rep. William Bankhead (D., Ala.), discuss the significance of the historic occasion.

The special broadcast will originate from the house chambers and will be aired by the NBC, CBS, and Mutual networks at 11 Saturday morning.
