

# War Broadcasts In English Scheduled On Short Waves

Band Lengths And Hours For Programs Given:  
WLW To Stay On Air 24 Hours Daily,  
Says Executive

Americans interested in war news broadcast from Europe in English, by foreign radio stations giving war news broadcasts, can find it on these wave lengths:

From London 11.75 megacycles, 25.5 meters at 4:30 p.m. (EST), 7:30 and 11. From Berlin, 11.7 meg., 25.4 M., at 6 p.m., 8:15 and 10:30. From Budapest, 9.12 meg., 32.8 m. at 7 p.m. from Paris 11.8 meg., 25.2 m., at 10 p.m. From Rome, 15.30 meg., 19.6 m. at 7:30 p.m.

The National Broadcasting Co. has announced a revised schedule of war news programs, highlighted by nightly roundup and an analysis of developments abroad, by John B. Kennedy, news commentator and noted writer and foreign correspondent. He will speak nightly at 7:15 over WEAF.

In addition, there will be 19 news periods which will present developments as reported by the Associated Press and other news services.

European week day pickups for WEAF 7 a.m., 11, 4:15 p.m., 6:15 (except Saturdays when it's 6:30) and 11. Sunday pickups will be at 7 a.m., 11, 4:15 p.m., 9 and 11.

Over WJZ on week days 7 a.m., 11, 4:15 p.m., 9 and 11. Sunday pickups for WJZ-NBC 7 a.m., 6:15 p.m., 9 and 11 p.m.

Station WLW will remain on the air 24 hours a day to bring European news when American press associations and networks indicate their plans to function past the normal deadline. James D. Shouse, vice president of The Crosley Corporation in charge of broadcasting, announced this week.

During the time of the European crisis and its culmination in warfare, WLW stayed on the air constantly.
