**Ilka Chase Will Match Wits With Gag Master;
Cal Tinney Plans New Quiz With
"Youth Against Age"**

Ilka Chase, star of numerous Broadway productions, regarded by producers as and possessing one of the keenest wits in the theatre, will achieve further notoriety as Milton Berle's first female guest gag-buster during the Stop Me If You've Heard This One broadcast over WEAJ Saturday at 8:30 p. m.

Don Bestor and his orchestra will provide musical interludes. Bestor is noted for his predominately sweet arrangements of current hits.

With Uncle Ezra astride a broomstick, and the cast bobbing for crab-apples in a finger bowl, the National Barn Dance will hold its annual Halloween frolic Saturday at 9:00 p. m., over WJZ. Among those attending the pumpkin fest will be Louise Massey and the Westerners, Lulu Belle and Scotty, the Vass Family, Hoosier Hot Shots, Lucille Long, contralto, the Maple City Four, aled and abetted by Glenn Welby's orchestra.

Ray Collins, one of the East's outstanding radio character actors, who has just arrived in Hollywood for his first motion picture role, and Paula Winslow, well-known character actress of the Western stage and screen, will be co-featured in "Profits, Unlimited," Arch Oboler's drama over WEAJ, Saturday at 10:30 p. m.

"Profits, Unlimited" is a fantasy adventure concerning events which might take place (in the far distant future, of course) if big business were to lose sight of the human factor and concern itself wholly with the increase of output and dividends by means of straight-line production methods.

Mildred Bailey's second appearance on Benny Goodman's Saturday program resulted in such an enthusiastic reaction from the listeners, that the "Queen of Swing" will join the "King of Swing" on the air as a regular attraction commencing Saturday at 10 p. m. over WEAJ.

Miss Bailey, who has been prominent as a jazz and blues singer ever since she left a 10-cent store piano to become a professional, possesses a voice that blends beautifully with the Goodman music. Her rich, throaty tones contrast vocally with the full instrumental rhythms of Benny Goodman's orchestra.

The songstress will sing many of her famous songs, as well as new numbers that will be specially arranged for her to do in conjunction with the orchestra.

Ray Whitley's 6-Bar Cowboys, musical unit appearing with the Rodeo in Madison Square Garden, will be guests of the Old Ranger during Death Valley Days, Saturday at 9:30 p. m., over WEAJ. The boys, with two guitars, a fiddle, washboard, two frying pans and two automobile horns, will present their own arrangements of cowboy songs and specialty numbers. The Old Ranger will entertain with the Story of Emmeline, cook on the 6-Bar Ranch who made the boys sing for their supper, her heavenly doughnuts being something of an incentive.
