

Radio's Youngest Harmony Team Will Be Heard Monday

Joan And Marianne Moylan, 5 And 7, Scheduled On Alec Templeton's Program Over WEAf At 9:30 A. M.

Peggy Joan and Marianne Moylan, who at 5 and 7 years of age are radio's youngest harmony team, will guest star with Alec Templeton, Monday at 9:30 p. m. over WEAf. The tots made their debut on a children's hour two years ago and are currently featured on their own series of weekly broadcasts.

Quizmaster Dr. Harry Hagen will move his "True or False" program to Yonkers for the broadcast of Monday at 8:30 p. m. over WJZ. A team of six lawyers from the Yonkers' Lawyer-assn will face a squad of six professional women from the Business and Professional Women's club.

A musical salute to Poland will feature the C ronation hour, Monday, at 10 p. m., over WEAf.

Opal Craven, the Lullaby Lady, will sing Stojowski's "Oj Lu Lu," while the Continentals quartet offers selections from "Halka" by Moniuszko. Paderewski's "Pilgrims' Song" will be heard as a violin and cello duet, and other orchestral and vocal selections are a march medley by Leopold, Chopin's Polonaise in A Major, the Mazurka from "Polonia" by Leopold, "Norkoza" by Belzackiego, "Kosciuszko Polonaise" by Leopold, "Boze cos Polske" by Kurpinski, and Stojowski's "Salem Na Zagonie."

Massenet's ballet music from "Le Cid" has been chosen by Guy Frazer Harrison to open the Rochester Civic orchestra concert, Monday, at 9 p. m., over WJZ. Harrison also has programmed "The Lake at Sunset" by Magagnoli, and Weber's overture to "Euryanthe."

Altho written about half a century ago, the "Sherlock Holmes" adventure scheduled Jan. 29 has especially timely interest. "The Second Stain" is a story of espionage in high government circles and the disappearance of important national secrets which, if unrecovered, will surely bring a war. And the turn of events puts a lovely lady in a very precarious position until the redoubtable Sherlock goes to work. Holmes will be played by Basil Rathbone, Dr. Watson by Nigel Bruce and the script is adapted by Edith Meiser. "Sherlock Holmes" is heard over WJZ each Monday at 8 p. m.

Margaret McCrae, one time vocalist on Show Boat, will be guest songstress for Tommy Riggs and Betty Lou Monday at 8 p. m. over WEAf.

Two interesting medleys, entirely dissimilar in character, will be presented by Maestro Andre Kostelanetz as orchestral highlights of the "Tune-Up Time" broadcast, Monday, at 8 p. m. over WABC. Since his visit to the Jackson Hole country in Wyoming last summer, "Tune-Up Time's" music director has been working on the medley of western songs which he will play during this broadcast. Of the large number available, he selected "Home on the Range," "Pony Boy," "Twilight on the Trail" and "Arkansas Traveler" for his western medley.
