

Broadcast of Sandburg's Tonight at 8

An original air drama by Robert E. Sherwood, based on Carl Sandburg's four-volume work, "Abraham Lincoln — the War Years," and starring Raymond Massey in the title role, will be presented tonight on the Cavalcade of America broadcast at 8 over stations WIBA and WENR.

Sherwood has selected 14 incidents from the crowded record of those turbulent Civil war years for Massey to enact. The drama starts with Abe's farewell address at Springfield and ends with the final tragedy. As usual, the Gettysburg address will highlight the program.
