

Toscanini Presents All-Debussy Program on Radio Tonight



Now in his 35th year as a star, Francis X. Bushman, leading man of the CBS daytime serial "Stepmother," is a veteran of 10 years before the microphone. The former matinee idol and silent screen star began his career at the age of 9 in stock. He has also been in turn, a professional strong man, wrestler, six-day bike racer and sculptor's model.

An all-Debussy program, with Jarmila Novotna, Czech soprano, as soloist in the title role of the "Blessed Damsel" in the Debussy cantata will be presented by Arturo Toscanini and the NBC Symphony orchestra tonight at 9 over WCFL (on WIBA at 9:30).

Hertha Glatz, contralto, and a chorus of 17 voices also will take part.
