Production Scheduled For 8 P. M. Monday; Margaret Speaks To Sing Numbers From Popular Operas

William Powell and Myrna Loy move into the Radio theatre for a one night stand on Monday, in the breezy mystery story, "After the Thin Man." Cecil B. DeMille will interview "The Maid of Cotton" in between the acts of the production that starts at 8:00 p. m. over WABC.

Traditional Rumanian music will be presented during the Contented program, Monday at 9:00 p. m. over WEAf.

Some of the tunes have been loaned for this broadcast by Josef Cristea, Rumanian operatic tenor, who has appeared with the Chicago City Opera Company.

He on his "Tune-Up Time" broadcast has made special arrangements of such Gershwin favorites as "Rhapsody in Blue" and "Love Walked In" for his 45-piece orchestra. Other songs are "Embraceable You," "The Man I Love," "Strike Up The Band," "Lady Be Good," "Swanee," "Somebody Loves Me" and "Of Thee I Sing." Vocals are by Tony Martin and the Kostelanetz chorus.

"The Purple Hills," a new song from the score of the motion picture "Captain Caution," written by Phil Ohman and Foster Carling, will be given its radio premier during Alec Templeton Time, Monday at 8:30 p. m. over WEAf, sung by tenor, William Miller. Templeton's impression will be a college fight song based on Nevins' "Narcissus" and Pat O'Malley will sing a new novelty tune, "Olga Puloffski."

James Melton, tenor, will sing Meyerbeer's "O Paridiso" and Moya's "Song of Songs," and in duet with Francia White, soprano, Romberg's "Wanting You," during the "Telephone Hour," Monday at 7:00 p. m. over WEAf.
