Charlie McCarthy, Edgar Bergen's seedling Shake- Delphos Will

DELPHOS, June 22—Plans have been completed for the visit here Sunday of hundreds of apiarists for the fifth annual field day of the Tri-County Beekeepers-assn in Waterworks park, according to Simon Allen, secretary of the or-ganization. The session will open at 1 p. m.

Speakers will be here from Ohio, Michigan and Indiana. Delphos has been selected annually for the field meet owing to its being an important center in the bee and honey industry. There are probably 5,000 colonies of bees owned by Delphos residents and distributed thru the surrounding countryside and ap-proximately twice that number of colonies in the Delphos area. In this territory, during a normal about 1,000,000 pounds of authorities honey are produced and authorities place the value at \$70,000.

Delphos is considered the largest shipping point for the sweet in the United States.

This community is one of the greatest producers of alsike seed in Ohio. Bees are important factors in this production as they pol-hnate the clover bloom as they gather the nectar. The tri-county organization is unique, inasmuch as it is believed to be the only organization of its kind in the nation-composed as it is-virtually of all commercial beckeepers.
