Seversky, who came to America after a brilliant World war record with the Russian Air Force, made his name here by demonstrating to the army air corps that the way to sink a tattleship by plane was to drop bembs alongside the ship instead of stop it. The bombs exploding in the water opened the ship's scams and sank it.

Seversky later supplied the air force with an improved bomb sight, a basic trainer aircraft and the Seversky pursuit plane. He became well known as a manufacturer of commercial planes and in 1933 flew one of his own planes to break the world's speed record for auntilbians. amphibians.
