

# Famous Blind Doctor Will Be Heard On Ripley Program

Woman Who Lied About Age And Worried Rest Of Life To Be Featured By "The Old Ranger"

A doctor who continued to practice 25 years after he became blind will be the guest of Robert L. Ripley on the latter's "Believe It Or Not" program at 9 p. m. Friday over WABC. The doctor, J. Thomas Clack, of Wadley, Ala., and his wife, who acted as his eyes thru those years, will explain how they overcame the handicap.

A woman who lied about her age and worried about the lie the rest of her life is the Old Ranger's principal character in his true story of "Death Valley Days," Friday at 7:30 p. m. over WJZ. The lie was given on her 30th birthday, just before her marriage. She registered on the marriage certificate as 23 years old, and did not reveal that she was actually five years older than her spouse. How she confessed the lie 40 years later, and the surprising consequence give the story an unexpectedly happy ending.
