

Radio Guild Will Present "Life's Hungry Man" Story

Ranch Boys Return To Guest Star On National
Barn Dance; Uncle Ezra Plans
"Jam" Session

"Life's Hungry Man," the story of Thomas Wolfe as dramatized by Gordon Webber of the National Broadcasting Company's Information Division, will be presented by the Radio Guild over WJZ Saturday at 8:30 p. m.

Webber, who will be remembered for previous Radio Guild plays such as "Peter-Lovely's Pigeons" and "Crazy Heart Blues," has been soaking himself in Wolfe's writings

for the past five years. He feels that his drama will throw new light on the life of that somewhat mysterious individual and go far to explain the reason for his untimely death on Sept. 15, 1938.
