

Prominent Stars Cast In "Wings Of Navy" At 9 P. M.

George Brent, Olivia De Havilland And John Payne In Radio Theatre Drama; "I Love A Mystery" Features Murder Story

A timely drama comes into the Radio Theatre on Monday, Oct. 7, when Cecil B. DeMille presents George Brent, Olivia DeHavilland, and John Payne in "Wings of the Navy." The intense story of U. S. Naval aviation will be broadcast over WABC at 9:00 p. m.
