

Rooney, Judy Garland Will Offer "Strike Up The Band"

Radio Theatre Program Set For 9 P. M. Monday;
Richard Crooks To Be Heard From
Chicago

That phenomenal young man who is at the top of the movie boxoffice heap by a healthy margin, Mickey Rooney, teams up with his movie playmate, Judy Garland, to make the Radio Theatre a gala event on Monday. "Strike Up the Band," one of their recent cinematic triumphs, is the play they'll do under the producership of William DeMille, who is substituting for his brother Cecil B. DeMille for the broadcast over the Columbia network at 9:00 p. m.

Richard Crooks, tenor star of the Metropolitan Opera Co., will be heard from Chicago Monday at 8:30 p. m., over WEA. Crooks will sing Fourdrain's "Chevauchee Cosaque," "My Message" by D'Harde lot, Totsi's "Parted," and "Mother O' Mine" by Tours.

Alfred Wallenstein will lead the orchestra in Verdi's prelude to "La Traviata," Brahms' Hungarian Dance No. 6, and Strauss "Thousand and One Nights" waltz.

Selections from the works of Franz Liszt, San Sibelius and Victor Herbert will be featured on next Monday's The Telephone Hour program, October 28th, 8:00 to 8:30 p. m. over WEA. James Melton will sing Del Riego's Green Hills of Ireland, and Kern's The Night Was Made For Love. Liszt's Second Hungarian Rhapsody and Sibelius' Valse Triste will be played by the Bell Symphonic orchestra led by Donald Voorhees, and Francia White will highlight the Spring Song from Natoma by Herbert.

Percy Bysshe Shelley, English revolutionist who just happened to express his ideas in some of the world's most beautiful poems such as "Prometheus Unbound," "The Revolt of Islam" and "Queen Mab," will be the subject of Zachary Metz's "Adventure in Read-

ing" over WJZ Monday at 10:30 p. m.

The Spring Song, from Victor Herbert's opera "Natoma," will be Francia White's soprano solo for the Telephone Hour, Monday at 8:00 p. m., over WEA. James Melton, tenor, will sing "Green Hills of Ireland" by Del Riego and Kern's "The Night Was Made for Love." The two artists will offer Yradier's "La Paloma" as a duet.
