Emil Berggruen will meet his brother, who has been "dead" for forty years, on Bob Ripley's WABC broadcast, Friday, at 10 p. m. Mr. Berggruen, an insurance company executive in Germany, had last seen his brother, Edward Walter, in 1889, when the latter left for the United States. Later the family received word that Walter had died. In 1938 Emil came here as a refugee and registered at a hotel. A stranger remarked that he knew a chap in Denver with a name quite like Berggruen—fellow named E. Walter Von Bergren. Acting on a hunch, Emil checked up and sure enough the Denver man was his long "dead" brother who had become an opera singer, altered his name for professional purposes, and is now an instructor in the Plains Conservatory of Music, Denver. The brothers will be together with Ripley to unfold the full story of this amazing reunion.
