AIRCRAFT PLANT REOPENS AFTER FLOOD THREATS

BURBANK, Calif., Feb. 21 — (AP) — The Lockheed airplane plant, working 24 hours a day on defense contracts and bombers for Britain, resumed full operations today after a partial shutdown due to rain.

Heavy rainfall, flooding lowlands around the factory, made passage from one building to another difficult and stalled numerous automobiles in the area, impeding traffic.

About 4,000 men on two night shifts last night were sent home or told to remain home, the company said, but a full force resumed work this morning.

There was no damage to airplanes.
