Music and youth furnish the theme of the Al Pearce program Friday over WABC at 7:30 p. m., with all the comedy cast also paying homage. Reason for the theme will be the guest appearance of two clever young musicians, Joan Whitney, one of BMI's top writers, and Eileen Wilson, 18-year-old junior at UCLA and staff singer at CBS's Hollywood station KXX.
