

# Conduct ky Concert Finale

Arturo Toscanini will end his fifth season with the NBC Symphony orchestra tonight, presenting an all-Tschaikowsky concert from the same platform which the composer conducted Carnegie hall's dedication concert 50 years ago.

Vladimir Horowitz, the conductor's son-in-law, will be piano soloist in the concert, which will be broadcast by WCFL at 8:35 and by WIBA beginning at 9:30.
