Chief Executive To Be Heard From 4 To 4:15 P. M. Via Combined Networks Of National Broadcasting Company

President Roosevelt will speak to the nation Friday from 4 to 4:15 p. m. over the combined coast-to-coast networks of the National Broadcasting Company, it was announced today.

The President, it is believed, will discuss dangers inherent in the war in Europe.
