## DRAFTEES WILL BE EXAMINED AT LIMA STATION

WAPAKONETA, July 12—Auglaize-co draftees in the future will be sent to Lima for their army physical examinations instead of Toledo, clerks in the selective service office announced today.

This method of examinations is designed to eliminate hardships occasioned by registrants who pass their local examinations only to be rejected at the induction center.

Two youths, Melvin Vallo and Luke Knapke, both of Munster, comprising call No. 22, were sent to Toledo for induction Friday. The next call for 13 men are scheduled to go to Lima July 25 for their examinations.
