

Selective Service Lottery Broadcast to Highlight Air Tonight at 6 on WIBA



Dickie Monohan—you know him as "Dinky Dugan" of "Reg'lar Fellers" heard Sundays on NBC—is a theatrical veteran at seven. The tow-headed youngster has worked in vaudeville, radio and picture shorts.

When the numbers are drawn tonight in the nation's second selective service lottery, radio will be on hand to report the event to the nation. In a broadcast at 6 over WIBA-WLS, Gen. Lewis B. Hershey, selective service director, will speak briefly before Secretary of Navy Knox puts his hand in the capsule-filled jar. WGN will carry the broadcast at 6:15.

After the numbers are announced from Washington, WIBA's special events staff members will contact Dane county men with the first-drawn numbers and get them to the studios in time for interviews on the 9:20 broadcast. The program also will include reading of the names of the 25 men in each of Dane County's four draft board areas whose numbers were drawn first.
