CIO MACHINISTS STAGE STRIKE AT STEEL PLANT YOUNGSTOWN, O., Sept. 17-

(AP)—Three thousand workers were idle and operations at a standstill today in the finishing plant of the Carnegie-Illinois'Steel Co. in the suburb of McDonald, as the result of an "unauthorized" walkout of CIO machinists.
