

Les Damon Will Make Plane Trip To Chicago For Show

Betty Winkler To Co-Star On Program Set at 7 P. M. Saturday; Lulu Belle and Scotty Return To Barn Dance Outfit

Les Damon, who plays the title role in "Adventures of the Thin Man" series, will fly from New York to Chicago in order to make another of his frequent guest appearances on "Knickerbocker Playhouse" Saturday at 7 p. m. over WEAF.

Damon is to be co-starred with Betty Winkler, one of NBC's most outstanding Chicago artists, in "Come Down to

Earth," the story of a headstrong parachute-jumping soldier.

Others in the cast include Hugh Studebaker, Ed Prentiss, Frank Dane and Marvin Miller. Owen Vinson will direct against a background of music written and conducted by Robert Trendler.

A double celebration, Lulu Belle and Scotty Wiseman's return as regular members of the "National Barn Dance" cast, and the Hayloft Ladies Night Party, will occur during the broadcast Saturday at 8 p. m. over WEAF. Lulu Belle and Scotty have appeared only infrequently for the past two years.

Tunes for the Ladies Night Party will include "Spanish Cavalier" by the Dinning Sisters, "Leibestraum" by Banjoist Eddie Peabody, "Single Girl" by Lulu Belle, "City Called Heaven" and "Some One" by Smiling Ed McConnell, "The Ladies Man" by Scotty, "Wasn't It You" by blues singer Jane Kaye, "It Doesn't Bother Me" by Andy Andrews, two numbers by the Hoosier Hot Shots and a grand finale of "Nighty Night" and "Good Night Ladies."

Ezio Pinza, Metropolitan Opera basso, stars as guest singer on "America Preferred" over WOR Saturday, at 8:30 p. m. His songs include "Il Lacerato Spirito" from the opera "Simon Boccanegra" by Verdi; "Tu Lo sai" by Torelli; "Fiocca in Neve" by Cimara and "L'ultima Canzone" by Tosti. The orchestra is under the direction of Alfred Wallenstein and Deems Taylor is narrator.
