

# University Anniversary Fe

A special dramatic tribute to the University of Chicago, which is climaxing its 50th anniversary celebration this week, will be broadcast tonight at 7:30 through WENR. Under the title "What is a University?" the broadcast will dramatize typical research achievements selected from more than 60,000 research reports. Dramatic portions of the broadcast will describe the unfolding of the tale of Darius, the king of Persia, by expeditions of the University of Chicago's Oriental institute; the establishment of a more accurate parole system by Ernest W. Burgess, University of Chicago sociologist; the formulation of the planetesimal hypothesis of the origin of the solar system; and the discovery and perfection of ethylene gas now widely used as an anesthetic.
