Admiral Yates Stirling, Jr., whose analyses of naval affairs are published frequently by The State Journal, will be one of tonight's speakers on America's Town Meeting of the Air. The broadcast, scheduled at 8:15 over WENR, will be devoted to "The Outlook in the Pacific."
