

Famed Quiz Kid To Appear On "Hobby Lobby" Broadcast

Gerard Darrow, Child Wizard, Will Tell Of Bird
Lore; Columbus Savant Also Scheduled
On Show

A 10-year old boy, who is a life member of the renowned Chicago Academy of Sciences, a life member of the National Audubon society, a leading ornithologist, a lecturer and a book reviewer, will be guest star on Dave Elman's "Hobby Lobby" program, Saturday at 8:30 p. m. over WABC. The child wizard, Gerard Darrow, of Chicago, is the youngest member of radio's famed "Quiz Kids" program.

Gerard, a human encyclopedia, devotes most of his spare time to the study of birds—their habits, appearance, structure and identification. At the age of four, he could identify 365 varieties. Gerard will tell of his interesting hobby, including many little known facts about his feathered friends.

Another interesting hobbyist will be Dr. C. C. Weldemann, of Columbus, a professor of mathematics at the Ohio State university, whose hobby is making and playing musical instruments built out of scraps of anything from metal to fossil bones.
