FAIR PROGRAM IS UNCHANGED, BROWN ASSERTS

COLUMBUS, O., Jan. 13—(AP) —Ohio's state fair and the 92 county and independent fairs will be held as usual this year, despite the war, Agricultural Director John T. Brown asserted today.

"To accomplish the important work that lies before us it is necessary to maintain the morale and interest of agriculture," he remarked.

Applying for dates for the annual expositions, fair managers from all parts of the state indicated the stress on farm production in wartime would contribute to the success of this year's fairs.

Fair dates are to be assigned at the annual convention of the Ohio Fair Managers' Assn here Jan. 11-15.

Ashley fair in Delaware-co seeks to open the season with an exposition July 15-18. The Putnam-Allen Independent fair at Columbus Grove has applied for the latest date, Dec. 16-18.

Most fairs will be a week later this year because the basic date, Labor Day Sept. 7, falls on its latest possible date.
