

Met Opera Lyric Soprano Is On "Great Moments In Music"

Stella Andreva Joins Stars In Presenting Favorite Airs Of Offenbach's "Tales Of Hoffmann"
At 10:15 Over WABC

Stella Andreva, lyric soprano of the Metropolitan Opera, will make her first appearance on "Great Moments In Music" to join Jean Tennyson, Suzanne Sten, William Hain and Robert Weede in presenting favorite airs from Offenbach's "Tales of Hoffmann", conducted by George Sebastian, over WABC on Wednesday at 10:15 p. m.

William Hain will sing the tenor role of Hoffmann in the musical story of the young poet and his disillusioning love affairs. Miss Tennyson, soprano, will sing the roles of Antonia and Giulietta, and Miss Andreva will be heard as Olympia.

A reshuffling of WABC programs on Wednesday night shifts "Meet Mr. Meek" from his usual 7:30 p. m. spot to 8 to 8:30 p. m. the same night.
