

March Of Time To Dramatize Kai-Shek's Uprising

Program Designed To Unite Millions
Of Chinese And Indians Against Axis
Told At 9:30 P. M. Friday

March of Time Friday night will dramatically dramatize the greatest mass uprising since the 1911 revolution. Generalissimo Chiang Kai-shek's plan to unite 400,000,000 Chinese and 375,000,000 Indians in a common front against Japan and Axis powers. The program, "The March of Time," will be broadcast over WJZ at 9:30 p. m.

The re-enactment will portray Chiang's early life from his days as a military cadet through his first month with Indian leaders Nehru and Gandhi. The audience will be taken "on stage" for his courtship of the beautiful Mei-ling, his sensational 1936 kidnaping, and his great victory over the Japs at Changsha last fall.

Elia Kazan, the Broadway actor who is also director of "Crown Point," a current Great White Way success, and Keenan Wynn, son of Ed Wynn and a popular actor in his own right, will be ringleaders in whatever happens during the "Grand Central Station" drama, Friday at 7:30 p. m. over WEAJ.

With Lou Holtz, yarn-spinning comedian, and Olyn Landick, "The Hackensack Gossip" in return engagements, Akte Smith will present an all-comedy Variety Hour over WABC Friday, at 8:00 p. m. A third funster, as yet unnamed, also will be heard.

Emil Ludwig, the biographer, will be on "Information Please" Friday at 8:30 p. m. over WEAJ, to match wits with John Kieran, Franklin P. Adams and Oscar Levant under the chairmanship of the unfazed Clifton Fadiman.
