Request Numbers May Be Heard On Program At 8:30 P. M.; Ellen Drew And Walter Pidgeon Will Offer Comedy

Richard Crooks will feature four popular request numbers on "Vice of Firestone" Monday at 8:30 p. m. The tenor's solos are to be Tschaiikowsky's "None But the Lonely Heart," "The Old Refrain" by Kreisler, "Ah, Sweet Mystery of Life" by Victor Herbert and Sanderson's "Until."

The orchestra under Alfred Wallenstein will be heard in Sousa's "Semper Fidelis," Spanish Dance No. 1 by de Falla, and Chaminade's Scarf Dance.
