Joan Blondell and Edward Arnold will be Milton Berle's guests Tuesday, at 8:30 p. m. over WJZ, the night the show shifts from a previous Friday night berth. Besides Milton Berle, Three Ring Time regularly features songs by Shirley Ross and music by Bob Crosby's Orchestra.
