"Mi Sueño Azul," composed by Gonzales, his marimba player, will also be heard. Additional numbers are "Calientito," "Penthouse Serenade," "South of the Border," "Rumba Rumbeto," "Dark Eyes," "Don't Sit Under the Apple Tree," "Ali Baba," "Te Quiero Dijiste" and "Oye El Carbonero." Vocals are contributed by Margo, Carmen Castillo, Miguelito Valdes and Bert Parks, who also is master of ceremonies.

Radio's popular Fibber McGee and Molly and their 79 Wistful Vista neighbors will be back on the air Tuesday at 9:30 p. m. via WEAf after their first absence last week in seven years, due to

the death of Jim (Fibber) Jordan's father.

Billy Mills' orchestra will play "Everything I Love" and the "Kerry Dancers." The King's Men will sing "Lannigan's Shillalah," Bill Thompson, Isabel Randolph and Gale Gordon will also be featured.

Spring's arrival, now something more than an idle rumor, will be given more or less official status during the Red Skelton broadcast, Tuesday. Deadeye, Clem, Daisy and sundry other characters will share in the ceremonies, over WEAf at 10:30 p. m.

Tallulah Bankhead has the leading role in a radio version of "Dark Victory," at 8 p. m. Tuesday over WEAf. The tempestuous actress will be heard in an 11½ minutes of the play on the "Johnny Presents" program.
