

Walter Huston To Appear Guest On Berle's Show

Real Indian Chief To Be Heard
Heidt's Program Broadcast From
Oklahoma City

Walter Huston, veteran character actor of films, will return for a second guest appearance on the comedy-variety show, Tuesday at 8:30 p. m.

Helping emcee Milton Berle to keep things in a light vein will be songstress Shirley Ross and announcer Wendell Niles.

A real Indian chief will be one of the unusual guests on the Horace Heidt "Treasure Chest" program from Oklahoma City Tuesday at 8:30 p. m., over WEA. He is Albert Atockni, a Comanche Indian who lives in Apache, Okla., and he has promised to make Heidt an honorary member of the tribe if the band leader can learn their tribal dance. Others on the program include Frank Trooper, 70, who was one of the first persons to enter the state of Oklahoma when the territory was opened in 1889; Master Sergeant George E. Shulte, Army veteran of 21 years who was at Pearl Harbor when the Japs attacked and was one of the first Americans to take a shot at the enemy; Corp. Eric Roos, a military policeman in the United States Army who was born in Germany and spent most of his life there, and Mrs. Patricia Kelley, who works for the weather bureau in Oklahoma. Between guest interviews, Heidt's orchestra and soloists, including Frankie Carlo at the piano, Donna and her Don Juans, Mimi Cabanne and Fred Lowery, whistler, will offer unique arrangements of popular songs.

The stage will be set with the spotlight on the grand piano, Paul Whiteman and his symphony orchestra will be ready, the audience will be waiting—and Gracie Allen will walk out from the wings in a daze and a dazzling

new gown to music by the concert artist Gracie Allen" program, Tuesday at 8:30 p. m. over WEA.
