

Helen Hayes To Play Role In Radio Program

Helen Hayes, first lady of the theatre, will be the center in the procession of stars over "Caesar and Cleopatra" in the broadcast at 8 p. m. Monday, over WABC, with Ward Howe in "The Hymn From The North Star."

The inspired writing of the "Battle Hymn of the Republic," for which Julia Ward Howe is best known, of course, be a high spot in the play, which is based on incidents in the life of the abolitionist and militant advocate of woman's suffrage in the drama "The Champ." The play will include the attack on Charles Sumner at his desk in the chamber of the United States Senate by Representative Preston Brooks.

Cecil B. DeMille's Radio theatre presentation for Monday at 9:00 p. m. over WABC will be "The Champ," co-starring Wallace Beery and Josephine Hutchinson.

Vaughn Monroe and his orchestra with special vocalists start a new series on WABC Monday, at 7:30 p. m., and celebrate their third anniversary as a group at the same time. Monroe will lead the group with his trumpet and baritone singing and will feature such personalities as Marilyn Duke, Ziggy Talent, the Four V's male quartet and a new female quartet, the Four M's, heard with Vaughn for the first time in the premiere. Monroe will double from the stage of the Paramount theatre in New York, where he's playing for two weeks.

Margaret Speaks offers what is perhaps the most-requested song in her large repertoire — "Morning," by her nucle. Oley Speaks — on the "Voice of Firestone" Monday, at 8:30 p. m. over WEA.

The soprano also sings "Let My Song Fill Your Heart," "Estrellita" and "Neath the Southern Moon." The Firestone Symphony under Alfred Wallenstein, completes the broadcast with the Polonaise from "Mignon," Infante's "Ritma," and Beethoven's "Minuet in G."
