

# Dean Jagger, Native C To Be Heard On "Cav

## Robert Young Signed To Play Fi Harry M. Pulham On Radio Spot

Cavalcade of America will present Broadway's Dean Jagger in "Man of Iron," dramatic and most startling sea battle, at 8 p. m. Monday.

A native of Lima, six feet two, dark and handsome, Jagger was born into a non-professional family. His interests in show business were rapid—he's stage actor, vaudevillian, radio player, as well as film character and romantic lead.

In "Man of Iron," Cavalcade's dramatic sea saga written by Robert L. Richards, Jagger will portray John Ericsson, immigrant Swede who invented the retaliatory ship that defeated the first iron-clad vessel.
