

Cavalcade Of America Portray Life Of Eli W

Lawrence Tibbett Returns To Tele
Monday; Margaret Speaks Also
Feature Spot On Program

Karl Swenson, leading man of the Cavalcade to be starred in his eighth "Cavalcade of America" drama Monday at 8:00 p. m. over WEAF. The play about Eli Whitney that surprisingly has to do with the cotton gin, will present Swenson in the role of the ingenious nineteenth century inventor.

The story concerns Whitney's designing of the first production line—for the mass production of muskets with which to guard against a threatened invasion by Napoleon.

Lawrence Tibbett will return to the "Telephone Hour" Great Artists Series Monday for his second appearance with the Bell Symphonic Orchestra under Donald Vorhees, at 9:00 p. m., over WEAF.

The Metropolitan baritone, ranging from opera to musical comedy and spirituals, is to sing "Di Provenza Il Mar" from Verdi's "La Traviata;" "Give Me One Hour" from Rudolph Friml's "The White Eagle;" Sydney Homer's seldom-sung "Fiddler of Dooney" and the Negro spiritual, "Lord I Want To Be," in a special arrangement by his accompanist.

A rare microphone performance of the Gavotte from Prokofieff's "Classical" Symphony, featuring the Firestone Orchestra under Alfred Wallenstein, will highlight "The Voice of Firestone" broadcast at 8:30 p. m. Monday over WEAF.

Soprano solos by Margaret Speakes will be "My Hero" from "The Chocolate Soldier" by Straus.
