

"We, The People" To Have Two Unusual Personalities

Quartermaster General, World's Largest Purchaser, And Unknown Girl Who Launches Ship, Will Be Guests

Major General E. B. Gregory, who as Quartermaster General is the world's largest purchaser of commodities, and Elsie Papajohn, unknown Greco-American girl who launched a minesweeper by special permission of the President, will headline the guests of "We, The People" in the broadcast over WABC on Sunday at 7:30 p. m.

Dorothy Kirsten, 24-year-old lyric soprano considered by many to be America's most promising young vocal star, returns by popular request for the second time this summer to make a guest appearance on the Sunday "Family Hour" program featuring Deems Taylor and Al Goodman's orchestra, at 5 to 5:45 p. m. over WABC. Block and Sully, veterans of the

two-a-day vaudeville era which saw them, Jack Benny and Burns and Allen in their footlight glory, are the latest headliners to be booked for the "Star Spangled Vaudeville" program Sunday at 8 p. m. over WEAJ. They'll be in fast company, sharing honors with Al Jolson, returning from a tour of overseas bases, and Alec Templeton, the famed blind pianist and satirist. Walter O'Keefe is emcee and music is batoned by Raymond Paige.

When Andre Kostelanetz presents the first radio performance of "A Lincoln Portrait," by Aaron Copland, one of those he commissioned to portray outstanding Americans in music, on his program over WABC Sunday at 4:30 p. m., the narrator will be Carl Sandburg, famous poet and biographer of Lincoln. Guest singer with Kostelanetz will be Lydia Summers who will offer Cole Porter's "In the Still of the Night." Additional orchestral contributions include Johann Strauss' "Emperor Waltz."

Dedicating it to the officers and men at Camp Pine, N. Y., who voted it their favorite, Phil Spitalny's all-girl orchestra and choir will present "Abide With Me" as the hymn of the evening, in the "Hour of Charm" broadcast Sunday at 10 p. m. over WEAJ. In other program features, the soloists Evelyn, Vivien and Maxine will occupy the spotlight.

Religious music of all faiths is featured by Frank Black and his orchestra during their all-hymn series, "We Believe," over WEAJ Sunday at 4:30 p. m.
