## CUBAN CABINET IS COMPLETED

President Batista Completes  
Coalition Government For  
National Unity

HAVANA, Aug. 18 — (UP)—President Fulgencio Batista's new cabinet, completed yesterday morning with Dr. Ramon Zaydin Y Marques-Sterling, liberal, as premier, will be sworn in this afternoon.

The cabinet represented three weeks' negotiations by Batista for a coalition cabinet for national unity, and had every political party but one pledged to its support.

The exception was the Autentico party of Dr. Ramon Grau San Martin, candidate for president in 1940.
