

# Rationing Food Tonight Over WIBA

What American housewives may expect in the way of food rationing will be explained by Secretary of Agriculture Claude R. Wickard and Price Administrator Leon Henderson in a transcribed broadcast tonight on WIBA at 8:30. The transcription will be picked up from a nationwide hookup at 6:30.

Wickard and Henderson will speak on "The Meat Situation," and are expected to clarify the reasons for the present meat shortage, and possibilities of rationing it and other foodstuffs.
