Tyrone Power And Barbara Stanwyck
In Inaugural Offering Of Dramatic
Ninth Year

When the house lights are lowered and Monday for the 361st performance of the oldest full-hour and leading dramatic show. B. DeMille will present Tyrone Power and Barbara Stanwyck in a special adaptation of "This Above All" a love story with the present world struggle as the inaugural offering of the ninth season. The play will be heard at 9:00 p. m. over WABC.

"This Above All" is the love story of Clive (Tyrone Power) and Prudence Cathaway (Barbara Stanwyck), a British aristocrat. Clive has distinguished himself in the fighting at Dunkirk, but he is bitterly disillusioned about the war. He feels he is fighting merely to preserve the caste-burdened English social system, which he detests, and so plans to desert his regiment.

When Prue learns of Clive's intention, she tells him with eloquent simplicity what England means to her and to millions of others like her. She tells him he must think with his heart, as well as with his mind. "This above all," she tells him, "to thine own self be true." And Clive then feels his identity with the war.

Marian Anderson, one of the world's leading contraltos, will be the 17th member of the Telephone Hour's "Great Artist Series" when she is heard on that program next Monday evening, 9:00 to 9:30 p. m. over WAAF. For her first program Miss Anderson is including some spirituals which were the songs of her childhood.

Besides the spirituals, Miss Anderson's selections will be "Hallelujah" by Hummel and a well-known aria from Massenet's opera, "Le Cid". The Telephone Orchestra under the direction of Donald Voorhees will open the program with Tschaiikowsky's "Sleeping

Beauty Waltz. The program will include the "Serenade" by Wieniawski and a duet in G.
