

Dr. I. Q., 'the Mental Banker,' to Make WIBA Debut Tonight

WIBA will add another new feature to its broadcasts when Dr. I. Q., quiz show, makes it debut over the station at 8:30 tonight.

The program, now in its fourth year on radio, presents Jimmy McClain as the "mental banker" and master of ceremonies. McClain employs a dozen researchers who work up about 600 questions each week, from which 36 are chosen for the program. Between \$400 and \$1,500 is paid each week to members of the audience who answer the questions correctly.
