

# Orson Welles Depicts Life Of Webster In Radio Drama

Hollywood Prodigy Enacts Starring Role In Story Offered By Cavalcade Of America; Ferry Command Pilots Battle Women In Quiz Contest

Cavalcade of America will present as guest star at 8 p. m. Monday over WEAJ the consummate actor and imaginator who brought the Martians to the United States long before little demons stormed Pearl Harbor—the remarkable Orson Welles as Daniel Webster in “The Man Who Wouldn’t Be President,” an original story by Hector Chevigny telling of the first great step of an American toward peace with Canada and England and the sacrifices and scandals this step caused.

“The Man Who Wouldn’t Be President” is the actual drama of the life of Webster, financial genius who couldn’t pay his own bills, elderly man whose young wife had ambitions for him as President and with whom he agreed until the moment arrived for a certain decision.

“True or False” will weigh anchor in this city on Monday, when six ferry command fliers vie in a brain battle with six women workers from the Willow Run Bomber Plant at 8:30 p. m., over WJZ.

The distaff side from the Willow Run factory, world’s largest aircraft plant, will include Helen Aldrich, Norma C. Dennett, Ruth Reath, Geraldine Ricker, and Alice Hinkson. The fliers’ team will be captained by Master Sergeant Donald D. Boyer. The names of other team members are not definitely

It is the story of Emiliano Zapata, Mexican patriot and revolutionist, and of a woman who loved him and risked her life more than once to save his—the last time in vain.
