

Madeleine Carroll Pr Stirring Drama Monday

"I Was Married In Bataan," A True Story
Suled On "Cavalcade Of Americ
Program

Madeleine Carroll will appear on "Cavalcade" Monday at 8 p. m. over WEAF in a stirring true story, "I Was Married In Bataan."

She portrays Lt. Dorothea Daley who was in the Philippines and met Lt. Emanuel Engel just before the fateful December, 1941. The couple decided to get married. On a battlefield, under fire, their wedding ceremony was performed.

"Love Crazy," one of the screen's recent laugh hits, will be seen in Cecil B. DeMille's Radio Theatre offering Monday at 9:00 p. m. over WABC, co-starring William Powell and Hedy Lamarr.

"Love Crazy" is the story of the Irelands, Steve (William Powell, who played the role in the movie) and Susan (Hedy Lamarr). Their fourth anniversary finds them still as happy as on their wedding day, but their bliss is not destined to last. Susan's mother arrives unexpectedly, thereby spoiling what was planned originally as a quiet celebration of the occasion.
