

Ellery Queen Returns To Air With A World Series Mystery

Cartoonist George McManus And Singer Benay Venute Are Guests On First Post-Vacation Program

Jewel robberies and murders always have been his ken but Ellery Queen comes back to the air with an up-to-the-minute "Adventure of the World Series" Saturday at 7:30 p. m. over WEAF. George McManus, cartoonist of "Bringing Up Father" fame, and Benay Venute, radio and stage singing star now appearing on Broadway in "By Jupiter," will be the guest armchair detectives.

As Ellery returns for his first program after a summer vacation, he is called in by one of the World Series ball clubs to discover the whereabouts of a missing baseball bat. Importance of the bat is increased by the disclosure that it is the favorite of the Series' best hitter. The player is superstitious about his bat, depends on it, and the winning of the crucial game hinges on his performance.

Supporting Ellery will be Marian Shockley as Nick; Santos Ortega as Inspector Queen, Ellery's father, and Ted de Corsia as Sergeant Velle.

Dick Powell, popular motion picture actor, will be starred in "Campana Serenade," a new weekly series beginning Saturday, 10:15 to 10:30 p. m. over WEAF. Matty Malneck will conduct the orchestra for the tuneful variety programs and create all the musical arrangements.

The Honorable T. V. Soong, foreign minister of the Republic of China, addressing a mass meeting at Carnegie Hall under the auspices of United China Relief, will be heard Saturday, from 10 to 10:15 p. m. over WJZ.
