

# Ida Lupino And Bryan Will Star On Radio

"A Woman's Face" Is Called A Story  
With Psychological Overtones  
Templeton On Monday Schedule

Ida Lupino, Brian Aherne and Conrad Veidt star in "A Woman's Face," a stirring drama with psychological overtones, on the Radio Theatre Monday on WABC. For Miss Lupino, it will be another triumph for her many fans her remarkable dramatic actress.

Pianist Alec Templeton, possessing a rare combination of first-rate talent and satiric mind, is an unusual figure in the music world. He is equally at home playing a Chopin prelude a la Chopin, or a witty improvisation a la Templeton. Both will be heard on the "Telephone Hour" Monday at 9 p. m. over WAAF.
