

Ida Lupino And Bryan Will Star On Radio

"A Woman's Face" Is Called A Story With Psychological Overtones Templeton On Monday Schedule

Ida Lupino, Brian Aherne and Conrad Veidt will star in "A Woman's Face," a stirring drama with psychological overtones, on the Radio Theatre Monday evening at 8:30 p. m. over WABC. For Miss Lupino, it will be another demonstration for her many fans her remarkable dramatic actress.

Pianist Alec Templeton, possessing a rare combination of first-rate talent and satiric mind, is an unusual figure in the music world. He is equally at home playing a Chopin prelude a la Chopin, or a witty improvisation a la Templeton. Both will be heard on the "Telephone Hour" Monday at 9 p. m. over WEAF.

The program will open with a tribute by Donald Vorhees and the orchestra to the United States 167th anniversary.
