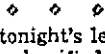


Will Broadcast er Grid Classic

Art Bramhall will be at the microphone Saturday when WIBA broadcasts the Wisconsin-Minnesota gridiron classic from Camp Randall stadium at 1:15 p. m.

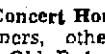

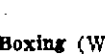

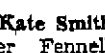
