

Man Who Regained Sight By Hobby Lobby Formula Invited

Modern Miracle Will Be Described, Also On
Hobby Lobby, On Saturday

A man who restored his lost eye-sight by practicing the unusual hobby of a former guest on Dave Elman's "Hobby Lobby" will describe this modern miracle—also on "Hobby Lobby" Saturday at 8:30 p. m. over WABC. Other guests include a celebrated literary figure whose hobby is proving that there's nothing new under the sun; and a man whose hobby is collecting humorous letters from debtors.

D. S. Kelly of Atlanta, Ga., lost his eyesight four years ago in an explosion. His optic nerve was paralyzed and he was completely blinded. While listening to a "Hobby Lobby" broadcast some time ago, he heard a hobbyist sing and tap his head at the same time

to get weird variations of the sounds. When Mr. Kelly adopted the hobby he experienced remarkable and unlooked for results! The constant tapping caused the optic nerve to swell. Now his sight is partially restored — and getting better all the time!
